Requested Rate Increase by Labrador Utilities

The following are my comments opposing the amount of the Interim Rate Increase as well as the proposed rate increase by Labrador Utilities, Inc.. You have granted an Interim Rate Increase from \$15 a month for both water and sewer to a flat rate of \$16.33 a month for water and \$22.79 a month for sewer, per lot, for a total of \$39.12 per lot.

Forest Lake Estates is a private community of over 800 lots plus an RV community. Labrador Utilities only recently purchased the water and sewer facilities for this community. The prior owner had fully developed the community water and waste facilities, including water meters to all lots, and only charged a flat rate of \$15 per lot for both water and sewer. The operation of the water and sewer facilities has been and still is a one person operation. The only increase in costs to the new owner, Labrador Utilities, should be their own costs for administratively collecting the monthly fees The Interim Rate increase amounts to \$24.12 per lot times a minimum 800 lots equals at least \$1929 a month. This is an excessive amount just to send out notices and collect checks.

I understand Labrador is trying to justify higher rates by increasing costs, such as by starting to use the water meters, thus hiring workers to read the meters and to lock and unlock the meters as lot water users move in or out. This is an entirely unneeded work force, especially as about two-thirds of the lot occupiers are "snowbirds" and only occupy the lots six months or less so do not have any water and sewer costs during their absence. A simple increase in the monthly rate would have covered all new administrative costs. Labrador is simply increasing costs without need to justify higher costs and thus the ability to make higher profits.
