Re: Test Year Notification Pursuant to Rule 25-6.140, Florida Administrative Code

Dear Mr. Olivera:

In response to your January 21, 2005, test year notification letter, Docket No. 050045-EI has been opened for Florida Power & Light Company's forthcoming general rate increase proceeding. It has been noted that the Company proposes to utilize a projected twelve-month period ending December 31, 2006, as the test year for the permanent rate increase proceeding. In addition, the Company is proposing that it be allowed to implement a subsequent year adjustment for 2007. However, the appropriateness of the selected test year may be an issue in the proceeding. The Company has not requested an interim rate increase.

The Minimum Filing Requirements and associated testimony will be due at the Commission's offices between March 22, 2005 and March 31, 2005. If the Company is unable to file by March 31, 2005, it must notify the Commission in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-6.140(3), Florida Administrative Code.
