**25-24.515 Pay Telephone Service.**

(1) – (9) No Change.

(10) Each pay telephone station ~~that~~ ~~which~~ provides access to any interexchange company shall provide coin free access, except for Feature Group A access, to all locally available interexchange companies. The pay telephone station shall provide such access through the forms of access purchased by locally available long distance carriers such as 10XXX+0, 10XXXX+0, 101XXXX+0, 950, toll free (e.g., 800, 877, and 888) access.

(11) –(17) No Change.

(18)(a) Except as provided in paragraphs (18)(b)–(d) below, each pay telephone station shall conform to sections 4.1.3(17), 4.2.4, 4.2.5, 4.2.6, 4.5.1, 4.31.2, 4.31.3, and 4.31.5 ~~703.7.2.3~~ and ~~704~~ of the ADA Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities, Appendix A to 28 CFR Part 36, (July 1, 2003 Edition) ~~American National Standards Accessible and Usable Buildings and Facilities, approved, by the American National Standards Institute, Inc. (ANSI~~
