Closure of Docket No. 041147-TX - Compliance investigation of Alternative RE:

Telecommunication Service, Inc. d/b/a Second Chance Phone for apparent violation

of Rule 25-22.032(6)(b), F.A.C., Customer Complaints.

On September 27, 2004, Docket No. 041147-TX was established to investigate Alternative Telecommunication Services, Inc. d/b/a Second Chance Phone's (Second Chance) apparent violation of Rule 25-22.032(6)(b), F.A.C., Customer Complaints. By Orders PSC-04-1247-PAA-TX and PSC-04-1247A-PAA-TX, issued December 17, 2004, and December 21, 2004, respectively, the Commission penalized Second Chance in the amount of \$120,000. The Commission further ordered that this docket shall be closed either upon the receipt of the payment of the penalties within fourteen days after the issuance of the Consummating Order or upon the cancellation of the company's certificate. On January 10, 2005, Order PSC-05-0027-CO-TX was issued making Orders PSC-04-1247-PAA-TX and PSC-04-1247A-PAA-TX, final and effective.

Fourteen calendar days have elapsed since the issuance of the Consummating Order and the company has not submitted its payment; therefore, Certificate No.5620 should be cancelled and this docket should be closed administratively.
