Issue 2: Should the Commission grant Supra Telecommunications and Information Systems Inc.'s Renewed Motion for an Interim Rate for a UNE-P to UNE-L Conversion Based on Changed Circumstances?

Recommendation: No. Staff recommends denying Supra's Renewed Motion for an Interim Rate because the Renewed Motion does not present a sufficient evidence that would justify the Commission to reverse or deviate from its prior ruling in Order No. PSC-04-0942-FOF-TP, issued September 23, 2004.

Issue 3: Should the docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. Staff believes this docket should remain open to address the merits of Supra's First Amended Complaint.
