Thank you for your letter dated February 5, 2005, regarding your opposition to the application filed in the above-referenced docket. In your letter, you indicated that you were told that you would not incur monthly charges for water and that you would only have to pay the \$900 initial charge. Unfortunately, this Commission does not have the jurisdiction to consider this type of dispute involving breech of contract.

The Commission's Division of Regulatory Compliance and Consumer Assistance advises that

	they have never received a single complaint from a customer of Raintree Utilities. Also, in any
	amendment or transfer application the Commission always investigates and insures that the utility has
JMP .	the financial and technical ability to provide service, and that it owns the land or has continued long-
COM	term use of the land on which the utility facilities are located. As to competitive quotations, a notice is
	provided to the municipal and county governing bodies, plus any privately owned utilities in the area.
CTR	Finally, most residential customers normally have 5/8" x 3/4" meters, and would be billed a base
ECR	charge of \$39 quarterly(\$13 monthly), plus \$1.40 per 1,000 gallons used. Of course, if you have a
GCL	larger meter, you would be billed the appropriate higher base charge.
OUL .	Please advise this Commission by March 16, 2005, if you intend to pursue your objection and
