Dear Mr. and Mrs. Lester:

Thank you for your letter dated February 7, 2005, regarding the application filed in the above-referenced docket. In your letter, you indicated that you object to the transfer and registration of Certificate No. 106-W to provide water service to Silver Oak Subdivision, by Raintree Utilities, Inc., 2100 Lake Eustis Drive, Tavares, Florida 32778. You then went on to list two separate objections, to include the questions of ownership and information on Raintree Utilities, Inc., and also expressed concern about a vague rate schedule.

	The Commission's Division of Regulatory Computative and Consumer Assistance advises that
	they have never received a single complaint from a customer of Raintree Utilities. Also, in any
	amendment or transfer application the Commission always investigates and insures that the utility has
MP	the financial and technical ability to provide service, and that it owns the land or has continued long-
MO	term use of the land on which the utility facilities are located. Finally, as to vague rate schedules, a
	standard residential customer has a 5/8" x 3/4" meter, and would be billed a base charge of \$39
TR	quarterly, with a usage charge of \$1.40 per 1,000 gallons. Of course, if you have a larger meter, you
CR	would be billed the appropriate higher base charge. I am told some customers do have meters which
	are larger than the standard 5/8" x 3/4" meter.

I believe you have made an error in referencing the certificate number. In this docket, we are dealing with Raintree Utilities, Inc., and its application to amend Certificate 539-W (not 106-W), pursuant to a Transfer Agreement entered into with RTG Properties, a Florida general partnership, located in Clermont, Florida. Certificate No. 106-W is held by Florida Water Services Corporation (Florida Water) for its Silver Lake Estates and other water systems. Florida Water has applied to transfer those facilities to Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. Because you refer to the Silver Oak Subdivision, and the well site to be transferred by RTG Properties is in the Silver Oaks Subdivision. presume you have filed your protest in the correct docket, but merely quote the wrong certificate number.
