On October 25, 2004, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-04-1037-PAA-TL, made final and effective by Consummating Order (CO) No. PSC-04-1132-CO-TL, issued on November 16, 2004, in Docket No. 041113-TL. The PAA Order directed Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (Sprint) to credit affected customers' accounts with a \$25-per-account rebate plus interest, as required by its Service Guarantee Plan, and to submit a report within 30 days of the issuance of the CO.

Sprint submitted its final report on December 16, 2004. Staff reviewed the report and determined that Sprint has complied with all of the terms of the PAA Order. Therefore, this docket should be closed administratively.
