**BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S AND
XO COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES, INC.'S JOINT MOTION
FOR CONTINUANCE**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) and XO Communications Services, Inc. (XO), pursuant to rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, file this Joint Motion for Continuance. BellSouth and XO request that the hearing currently scheduled for March 3, 2005 be continued to May 19, 2005 to allow the parties the opportunity to conduct discovery on the limited matters described below. As grounds therefore, BellSouth and XO state:

1. On February 28, 2005, BellSouth filed an Emergency Motion in Limine or, alternatively a Motion for Continuance.
2. XO does not concede that the late-filed deposition exhibits which are the subject of BellSouth's motion should be excluded. But in any event, the parties request that the hearing in this cause be continued until May 19, 2005. During that period, the parties request permission to conduct discovery limited to the appropriate amount of a true-up, if any, and the circuits to which such true-up should apply, if any.

WHEREFORE, BellSouth and XO request that this hearing be continued to May 19, 2005 and that discovery be permitted for the limited purpose described herein.
