NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS

The Florida Public Service Commission recently completed an investigation of rates and charges for North Peninsula Utilities Corporation's wastewater system. Pursuant to Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-05-0143-PAA-SU, issued on February 7, 2005, the Utility proposed and the Commission accepted the Utility's offer to refund 1.5% of all revenues collected from the implementation of the Utility's last index in August of 2002 through September 5, 2003 and to refund an additional 7.09% of revenues collected from September 5, 2003 through the date of implementation of reduced rates outlined below. Both of these refunds will be made, with interest, in accordance with the requirements of Commission Rule 25-30.360, Florida Administrative Code.

Also as a part of PAA Order No. PSC-05-0143-PAA-SU the Utility is also required to implement a slight rate decrease for its wastewater system on a going-forward basis. The new rates are reflected under the heading "new rates" in the schedule attached hereto.

PAA Order No. PSC-05-0143-PAA-SU was finalized by Order _____ issued on March _____, 2005. These new rates will go into effect in March _____, 2005 and will appear on your bills rendered 30 days on or after that date. The Utility is required by Commission Rule to complete refunds (as credits on your next three bills) within 90 days of March _____, 2005.
