COMES NOW, AT&T Communications of the Southern States, LLC, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006 Florida Administrative Code, and files its Motion for Extension of Duration of Orders Granting Confidential Classifications, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

- On October 1, 2003 Commission issued Order No. PSC-03-1083-CFO-TL Granting AT&T's Request for Specified Confidential Classification and Motion for Protective Order for Document No. 08368-03.
2. The reasons AT&T asserted in support of its Request for Specified Confidential Classification and Motion Protective Order continue to exist and pertain to the information. Specifically, there is still a need to protect proprietary business information and information which is not subject to public disclosure.
 3. The information requested remains in the possession of the Commission Staff.
 4. For the reasons set forth above, and in AT&T's original Request for Specified Confidential Classification and Motion for Protective Order, AT&T hereby requests that the Commission enter an Order extending the period of confidential classification for an

additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of Staff.
