#### APPLICATION OF DEBTOR TO EMPLOY ATTORNEYS AND DISCLOSURE OF COMPENSATION

or any other party-in-interest or their respective attorneys and accountants, or with the Office of the United States Trustee, or any employees of the Office of the United States Trustee, which are prohibited, which would interfere with or hinder the performance of counsel's duties herein, or which need to be described herein

WHEREFORE, the Debtor requests that it be authorized to employ and appoint Harris & Geno as its attorneys and legal counsel, effective February 22, 2005. The Debtor further prays for such other and more general relief as the Court may deem just.
