

Dear Ms. Napolitano:

Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc. holds a CLEC Certificate in Florida. In 2001, the Commission established Docket No. 011277-TX to fine the company \$1,000 for nonpayment of the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee and not providing the Commission with its updated address and phone number or cancel its certificate. You subsequently protested the Proposed Agency Action Order by requesting a hearing since the company had filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection and which was subsequently converted to a Chapter 7 proceeding. After several conversations with you, you wrote the Commission a letter dated March 14, 2002, withdrawing your petition for a formal proceeding and asking that the Commission refrain from cancelling Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.'s certificate for a period of three months from the date of your letter. A final Order was issued which closed the docket, did not reinstate the Proposed Agency Action Order and the certificate remained active.

Because the certificate remains active and because Regulatory Assessment Fees continue to accrue, in addition to the 2000 fee, Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc. now owes the 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 Regulatory Assessment Fees. From my understanding, it appears only the 2000 fee and applicable statutory late payment charges would be considered pre-petition debt.

Staff would like to get Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.'s certificate cancelled as it is our understanding the company is no longer in business and has need of its certificate. Since June 14, 2002, has long passed (the date mentioned in your March 14, 2002), staff would like to establish a docket to cancel the certificate due to the bankruptcy and request that permission be sought from the Florida Department of Financial Services to write off all unpaid fees, including statutory late

payment charges.

Please review this information and let me know by August 20, 2004, of any objection you may have in staff recommending that Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.'s certificate be cancelled due to the bankruptcy. Staff would prefer an up-to-date letter from you requesting cancellation of the certificate and asking that any unpaid fees be written-off. However, if you prefer, we could use your March 14, 2002, letter. Let me know if you have any questions. Thanks.

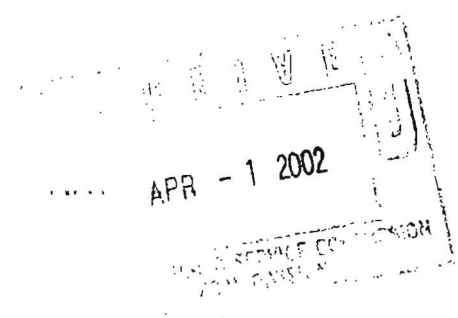

Do you have any information about this company? I seem to recall that you told me about a month ago that you had talked with the trustee and that she was going to send a letter requesting cancellation of the company's certificate. Just to give you a little more info, I had Docket 011277-TX for nonpayment of the 2000 RAF. The trustee, Roberta Napolitano, wrote a letter protesting the Order fining the company \$1,000 or cancelling its certificate because the company had filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy. I (and Legal) contacted her and asked her to write a letter requesting cancellation since the company was being liquidated. She kept promising to do so, but never did. Therefore, I took another recommendation back to Agenda and closed the docket, did not reinstate the PAA, and the certificate remained active.

Because of the delay in the trustee requesting cancellation, the company now owes 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 RAFs and applicable late payment charges. In doing research, I've found that the US Dept. of Justice has a website that oversees US Trustees. I was wondering if I could write DOJ a letter telling them about Ms. Napolitano and see if they can get her to write a letter requesting cancellation. I would really like to get this company off the books. All mail is being returned and phones are disconnected so the company does not exist. What do you think I should do?

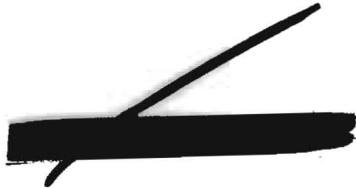
