


ISSUE 1: Should BellSouth be permitted to require a deposit from a CMRS carrier whose credit rating is as good as BellSouth's own credit rating?

ISSUE 2: Should MetroPCS be permitted to set off undisputed charges owed by BellSouth that are over ninety (90) days past due against amounts that MetroPCS owes BellSouth?

ISSUE 3: Should BellSouth be permitted to charge an unregulated, "market-based" rate for transiting traffic from MetroPCS to third party carriers, including CLECs and other ILECs and CMRS carriers?

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
