

c. Exhibit C is a table containing a line-by-line and page-by-page identification of the information for which confidential treatment is sought, and, with regard to each document or portions thereof, references to the specific statutory basis or bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavits in support of the requested classification.

d. Exhibit D comprises the affidavits of Korel M. Dubin, John Hartzog, Osvaldo M. Lom, Robert Onsgard, Pamela L. Sonnelitter and Gerard J. Yupp, who attest to the bases for FPL’s requesting confidential classification.

3. The information highlighted in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3). Pursuant to section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information (a) the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information; and (b) the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* §366.093(4), Fla. Stat.

WHEREFORE, for Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that this Request be granted.

AFFIDAVIT OF KOREL M. DUBIN

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Korel M. Dubin, who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. My name is Korel M. Dubin. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL's), Regulatory Affairs Department, as Manager of Regulatory Issues. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. With respect to Exhibit C, I have reviewed the documents and information for which I am listed as Affiant and which are included in Exhibit A to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification of Certain Information Obtained in Connection with Audit Control No. 05-031-4-1. Documents or materials that I have reviewed and which are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information contain or constitute competitively sensitive data, the disclosure of which would place FPL at a disadvantage in the marketplace and would cause harm to customers. Certain of the information would also place FPL at a disadvantage when coupled with other information that is publicly available. Also, certain of the confidential information includes customer-specific account information, including banking account numbers. It is FPL's corporate policy not to disclose customer-specific information.
