

Issue 2: What rates and charges should be approved for this utility?

<u>Recommendation</u>: The utility's existing monthly flat rate should be approved until authorized to change by the Commission in a subsequent proceeding. The tariff sheets reflecting this charge should be effective for services rendered or connections made on or after the stamped approval date.

# APPROVED

Issue 3: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: No. The docket should remain open pending receipt of a statement, with supporting documentation, from the utility that it has established books and records in compliance with the NARUC uniform system of accounts, including the ability to provide separate general ledgers for utility and non-utility records. Upon receipt of such statement, the docket should be administratively closed.
