**SPRINT'S REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER FOR
PROPRIETARY INFORMATION IN DOCUMENT NO. 05380-05**

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated ("Sprint") by and through its undersigned counsel, requests that the Florida Public Service Commission enter a Temporary Protective Order for certain proprietary information, filed with the Commission subject to a Claim of Confidentiality and provided to the Office of the Public Counsel as a party to this docket, exempting the information from s. 119.07(1), F.S. In support Sprint states as follows:

1. On June 3, 2005, Sprint filed under a Claim of Confidentiality certain information requested by Commission staff and contained in Document No. 05380-05 (highlighted portions of hurricane cost recovery – cost calculations spreadsheets).
2. Pursuant to section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes, Sprint has claimed the information contained in Document No. 05380-05 to be proprietary and confidential. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, Sprint is requesting this temporary protective order to protect the confidentiality of the information pending a determination as to whether it will be used in a proceeding before the Commission.


