### **OPC SUGGESTIONS FOR PSC SURVEY**

The Commission's official seal should be displayed on the front of the post card or envelope to each customer, together with the phrase in bold letters "THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION WATER QUALITY SURVEY." Identifying the post card or letter as an official PSC survey may help alert customers that the card or letter is not an unsolicited offer from sellers of water testing or conditioning equipment, and may result in an increased percentage of responses to the survey. The survey should be presented in the following manner:

### "Important Survey Concerning Your Water Quality"

This survey will help THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION determine if each customer of Aloha Utilities has any of the following problems, and the extent of those problems, with the water in domestic faucets during regular use.

	<u>Never</u>	Rarely (1-2x a year)	Occasionally (3x a year or more)	Frequently (once a month or more)	<u>Very</u> <u>Frequently</u> (at least once a week)	Continuously (daily)
Do you have a problem with black or discolored water?
