Please accept this letter as notification that C. Hurley Cox ("Cox"), President of Communications Network Billing, Inc. ("CNBI") is transferring control to Cristina Michele Tucker ("Tucker"). CNBI was authorized to provide long distance telephone services in the State of Florida by Consummating Order dated December 12, 2003, Docket No. 031051-T1.

Pursuant to the Stock Purchase Agreement, Cristina Michele Tucker will acquire control of CNBI through the purchase of 100% of the issued and outstanding stock of C. Hurley Cox. The company will continue to operate as Communications Network Billing, Inc. and only the underlying ownership of CNBI will change as a result of this transaction. The transaction will not result in a change in the manner in which CNBI provides services to its customers, in that it will continue to provide service under the rates, terms and conditions it currently offers to its customers.
