

Dear Ms. Bayo:

Enclosed please find Z-Tel Communications, Inc.'s Proposed Stipulated Facts for filing in the above-referenced proceeding. Z-Tel notes that BellSouth filed its proposal while the parties were in the midst of negotiations, which is at a minimum disappointing. Although Z-Tel believes that the parties would likely have been able to reach mutually-agreeable language with good faith negotiations, BellSouth acted unilaterally to foreclose that outcome. With the exception of paragraph 8 and some other modest word changes, the parties' proposals are largely similar, but have some substantive differences.

**PROPOSED STIPULATED FACTS OF
Z-TEL COMMUNICATIONS, INC.**


1. Z-Tel adopted the MCI WorldCom Communications Interconnection Agreement with BellSouth for Florida dated September 12, 2001; as a result, BellSouth and Z-Tel were parties to an interconnection agreement in Florida with an effective date of April 18, 2003 and an expiration date of September 11, 2004.
2. On January 21, 2004, BellSouth requested negotiations with Z-Tel for a new interconnection agreement.
3. On February 19, 2004, BellSouth sent Z-Tel a copy of BellSouth's proposed agreement.
4. On February 20, 2004, BellSouth forwarded a second request to Z-Tel for negotiations.
5. On March 22, 2004, BellSouth sent Z-Tel a third request for negotiations.
6. On April 20, 2004, BellSouth contacted Z-Tel regarding interconnection agreement negotiations.
7. From January 21, 2004 through May 20, 2004, Z-Tel and BellSouth had numerous discussions about a successor interconnection agreement.

8. On July 22, 2004, Z-Tel filed a notice with this Commission that it had adopted the interconnection agreement between BellSouth and Network Telephone in its entirety.
9. BellSouth did not agree to Z-Tel's adoption, and BellSouth objected to that adoption with this Commission.
10. In early August 2004, BellSouth indicated it would agree to Z-Tel's adoption of the Network Telephone and BellSouth interconnection agreement only if Z-Tel agreed to replace in its entirety Attachment 2, UNEs, of the Network Telephone and BellSouth interconnection agreement.
11. Network Telephone and BellSouth continue to operate under the same interconnection agreement that Z-Tel adopted.
12. The last amendment to the interconnection agreement between BellSouth and Network Telephone is dated May 20, 2005 and was effective May 24, 2005. The BellSouth/Network Telephone interconnection agreement has not been amended to reflect the *Triennial Review Order*¹ or the *Triennial Review Remand Order*.²
