I am writing in response to the questions raised in our application for certificate.

First, I would like to explain that although I was involved in Worldlink Long Distance, the circumstances were as follows: I was married to Peter Delatour the president of the company. And although I was an officer listed in the corporation and I worked in the office, my ex husband had 100% control of the company. The company never got on its feet. I was victim of domestic violence and am including a copy of the court order. It was unfortunate that my personal affairs interfered with my business involvement in Worldlink, but the circumstances were severe and beyond my control.

As to Biz-tel Corporation, that belonged solely to Peter Delatour and I had little to no involvement with that company. I applied for certification with A+ Communications because I wanted to start my own company; one having nothing to do with my ex-husband. I also applied because I have experience in the industry, good business relations with industry colleagues, and knowledge of the daily operations needed to run a successful telecom. When I was originally asked to respond regarding my involvement with Worldlink, I, at that point in time, decided to no longer pursue certification. Instead, I accepted employment in another telecom and postponed my dreams of running my own CLEC.

Worldtel Corp. will operate in compliance with all entities required. I, as representative of Worldtel, intend to operate the company to its fullest and best capacity. I have extensive experience in telecom of over five years. I gained my experience after Worldlink by working with companies such as Ingram Micro, THC, NYTEL, et.al. I, humbly request that the Commission give Worldtel the opportunity to operate as a CLEC so that the general public will have one more choice in Telecom Carrier. I understand that in giving Worldtel the opportunity, it will also be giving me a chance. I guarantee that under my sole supervision and/or control Worldtel will run as it should. Please consider that although business should never be affected by ones personal life, my involvement with Worldlink and the problem were unique and of serious nature.

**FINAL JUDGMENT OF INJUNCTION
FOR PROTECTION AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE (AFTER NOTICE)**

The Petition for Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence under section 741.30, Florida Statutes, and other papers filed in this Court have been reviewed. The Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter.

It is intended that this protection order meet the requirements of 18 U.S.C. § 2265 and therefore intended that it be accorded full faith and credit by the court of another state or Indian tribe and enforced as if it were the order of the enforcing state or of the Indian tribe.

HEARING

This cause came before the Court for a hearing to determine whether an Injunction for Protection Against Domestic Violence in this case should be issued () modified () extended.

FINDINGS

On 8/7/00, a notice of this hearing was served on Respondent together with a copy of Petitioner's petition to this Court and the temporary injunction, if issued. Service was within the time required by Florida law, and Respondent was afforded an opportunity to be heard.

After hearing the testimony of each party present and of any witnesses, or upon consent of Respondent, the Court finds, based on the specific facts of this case, that Petitioner is a victim of domestic violence and/or has reasonable cause to believe that he/she is in imminent danger of becoming a victim of domestic violence by Respondent.

INJUNCTION AND TERMS

This injunction shall be in full force and effect until indefinitely, or until further order of the Court. THIS INJUNCTION IS VALID AND ENFORCEABLE IN ALL COUNTIES OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA. The terms of this injunction may not be changed by either party alone or by both parties together. Only the Court may modify the terms of this injunction. Either party may ask the Court to change or end this injunction at any time.

Any party violating this injunction may be subject to civil or indirect criminal contempt proceedings, including the imposition of a fine or imprisonment, and also may be charged with a crime punishable by a fine, jail, or both, as provided by Florida Statutes.

This Commission has received your company's application for a Competitive Local Exchange Telecommunications Company (CLEC) Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. In answering question 15(b), you neglected to list your previous relationships with Worldlink Long Distance Corp. (Worldlink), A+ Communications, Inc., and Biz-Tel Corporation.

According to our records, Worldlink's IXC certificate was cancelled in Docket No. 001301-TI for violation of Rule 25-4.0161, F.A.C., Regulatory Assessment Fees, and Worldlink's CLEC certificate was cancelled in Docket No. 000219-TX for apparent violation of Section 364.183(1), F.S., Access to Company Records.

In Docket Nos. 011271-TI and 011382-TX, A+ Communications, Inc. applied for an IXC certificate and CLEC certificate, respectively. The certificates were denied by the Commission and the dockets were closed because you did not respond to Staff's inquiries for additional information regarding Worldlink and A+ Communications, Inc.

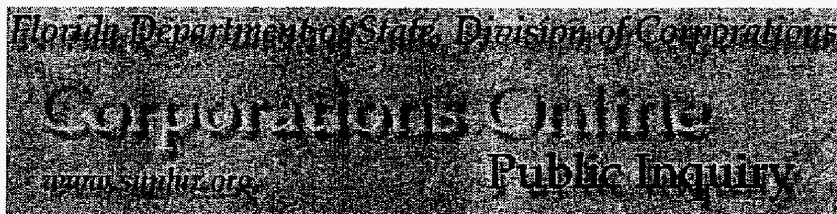

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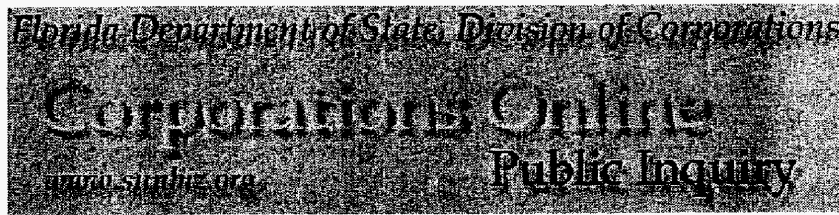

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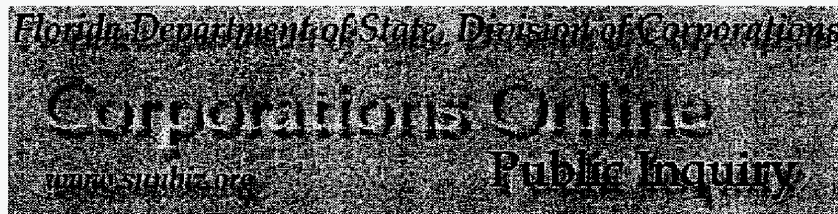
