

Consistent with the Commission's July 19, 2002 Order, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") is filing a Proposed Notification Report for the August 2005 data month and a Preliminary Notification Report for the data month of September 2005. These proposed changes will be discussed at the July 8, 2005 industry conference call.

Pursuant to the Commission's decision at the June 10, 2005 Administrative Session, BellSouth will remove all DS0 Wholesale Platform Circuits from the SQM and SEEM Reports.

PROPOSED AUGUST 2005 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth proposes making the changes described in this document to generate results for the August 2005 data month. Results for the August 2005 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results	September 20, 2005
Final results	September 30, 2005

BellSouth provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the Georgia Public Service Commission's Order of July 19, 2002. This order specifies that when BellSouth proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. BellSouth must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

The "Affected Measures" described in this notice are those set forth in the Georgia Service Quality Measurement ("SQM") Plan, unless otherwise noted. All "Impact of Change" descriptions are stated at the measurement level, unless the sub-metric level is specified.

Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (*e.g.*, LEO, LESOG, LMOS, WFA, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. Bellsouth will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as Releases are implemented.

Ordering Measurements

- (1) *Affected Measures:* O-7, O-8 & O-9

Description of Change: With the implementation of the ENCORE 17.0 Release in December 2004, LSRs that had potential jeopardies placed against them prior to the FOC being issued were being classified as Fully-Mechanized. BellSouth proposes to change the code to classify these LSRs as Partially-Mechanized. This proposed change was Item (1) on the Preliminary August Data Notification filed on June 1, 2005. (RQ6185)

Impact of Change: For March 2005, in Georgia, the result would change from 92.68% to 98.75% for the Fully-Mechanized Reject Interval. For the Partially-Mechanized Reject Interval, the result would change from 95.30% to 95.50%.

Provisioning Measurements

- (2) *Affected Measures:* P-3

Description of Change: Currently, for the Local Interconnection Trunk product in the Percent Missed Installation Appointment Aggregate Report, the Retail and Wholesale

End User Missed Appointment Columns are erroneously being populated with the BellSouth caused missed appointments. BellSouth proposes to change the PMIA report for Local Interconnection Trunks to correctly reflect these End User Missed Appointments. This proposed change was Item (2) on the Preliminary August Data Notification filed on June 1, 2005. (RQ6328 changed to RQ6864)

Impact of Change: No impact to measurement results. For February 2005, in Florida, 27 BellSouth End User Missed Appointments and 5 CLEC End User missed appointments were not reported.

- (3) *Affected Measures:* P-11 (Georgia, Florida, Kentucky, and Tennessee)

Description of Change: Currently, where multiple LSRs with the same PON exist and only one Service Order reflects that PON, only the LSR where both the PON and OCN match the Service Order is included in the data. BellSouth proposes to include the remaining LSRs in the data as a measurement failure. This proposed change was Item (3) on the Preliminary August Data Notification filed on June 1, 2005. (RQ6392)

Impact of Change: For February 2005, there were two such duplicate PONs in the Region and both duplicate PONs were in Kentucky. The measurement result would decrease by 0.13%.

Billing Measurements

- (4) *Affected Measures:* B-7 & B-8

Description of Change: Currently, the entire ZScore column for the Resale product on the 12-Month reports is not populated. BellSouth proposes to populate this column. This proposed change was Item (4) on the Preliminary August Data Notification filed on June 1, 2005. (RQ6110)

Impact of Change: None to reported results.

PRELIMINARY SEPTEMBER 2005 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the September 2005 data month. Results for the September 2005 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results	October 20, 2005
Final results	October 31, 2005

BellSouth provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the Georgia Public Service Commission's Order of July 19, 2002. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. BellSouth must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

The "Affected Measures" described in this notice are those set forth in the Georgia Service Quality Measurement ("SQM") Plan, unless otherwise noted. All "Impact of Change" descriptions are stated at the measurement level, unless the sub-metric level is specified.

ENCORE Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. BellSouth will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as ENCORE Releases are implemented.

Special Access Measurements

(1) *Affected Measures:* SA-7

Description of Change: Currently, past due circuits where the completion date has been applied but the status of the order is still pending in SOCS are not being included in this measure. BellSouth proposes to modify the PMAP data processing to assign all records that reflect a pending SOCS status as a candidate for this measure. (RQ6080)

Impact of Change: For April 2005, in Georgia, the PDC Distribution report currently reflects no records. After the coding modification the report would reflect 87 records.
