**ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR'S MOTION TO ENGAGE TEOCO TO CONDUCT A
COST MANAGEMENT AUDIT, ALLOW PAYMENT OF FEES AND COSTS,
AND PAYMENT OF A SECURITY RETAINER**

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard on July 1, 2005, in West Palm Beach, Florida, upon the Debtor-in-Possession's Motion to Engage TEOCO to Conduct a Cost Management Audit, Allow Payment of Fees and Costs, and Payment of a Security Retainer (the "Motion") and the Court having heard argument of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, therefore

1. That the Motion is GRANTED.
2. The Debtor is authorized to hire TEOCO pursuant to the terms of the Professional Services Agreement attached to the Motion, to conduct an audit of the Debtor's post-petition network cost invoices to identify billing errors, and file disputes and negotiate the settlements.
3. The Debtor is further authorized to pay TEOCO thirty-five percent (35%) of the dollar value of any settlements with vendors, to pay TEOCO a \$15,000.00 security retainer, and allow the Debtor to reimburse TEOCO for travel and other out-of-pocket expenses up to \$15,000.00. TEOCO

will provide the Debtor with monthly invoices.

4. TEOCO is directed to conduct weekly calls to update the Debtor on the status and submit bi-weekly, weekly and monthly reports to the Debtor. The Debtor will make the final determination on whether or not TEOCO is to proceed with disputes.
