RE: Docket No. 050467-TP - Recommendation to the Office of the General Counsel - Petition for expedited review of Pooling Administrator's denial of request for additional numbering resources for the Sanford exchange, by Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P.

On June 29, 2005, Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P., (Time Warner), submitted a request to the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for additional numbering resources in the Sanford rate center to meet a customers request. Also, on June 29, 2005, NeuStar denied the Time Warner application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for a new block of numbers.

On July 7, 2005, Time Warner filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources for the Sanford rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL (Docket No. 020087-TL), which approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the Time Warner petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (July 26, 2005), as outlined in the expedited code denial process orders. NeuStar should be directed to provide Time Warner the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Sanford rate center. Also, please allow staff assigned to the docket to
