RE: Docket No. 050448-SU - Application for a staff-assisted rate case by Colonial Manor Utility

On July 11, 2005, the RCA preliminary audit determined that Colonial Manor Utility (Colonial) had revenues of \$160,654 in 2004. Therefore, pursuant to Section 367.0814(1), Florida Statutes, the utility is not eligible for the staff-assisted rate case (SARC) filing. Although Colonial is considered a Class C utility by the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (annual revenues of less than \$200,000), it is not eligible for a SARC because the utility's gross revenues are above \$150,000.

The utility has not paid a filing fee. There has been no agency action taken and staff has determined that there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission. Therefore, pursuant to 2.07-C.2.c., Administrative Procedures Manual, this docket may be closed.)
