GULF POWER COMPANY'S JULY 2005 STATUS REPORT ON POLE SURVEY

Gulf Power Company ("Gulf Power"), pursuant to the Presiding Judge's April 1, 2005 Order, submits the following status report on the pole survey.

1. Number of poles to be surveyed: 150,000
2. Number of poles actually surveyed to date: 9,649 poles on first pass.
3. Number of poles estimated being at full capacity to date: Gulf Power estimates that 78% of the 9,649 poles collected are crowded. All of these poles collected are in the Pensacola, Florida area.
4. Any problems encountered with survey: Hurricane Dennis made landfall on the afternoon of Sunday July 10, 2005 between Pensacola Beach and Navarre Beach, Florida (within

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
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Gulf Power's service territory). As of Monday July 18, 2005, approximately 109 miles of primary wire, 26 miles of secondary wire, 365 poles, 957 transformers, 18,851 fuses and 81,355 connectors needed to be replaced or had been replaced as a result of the damage from Hurricane Dennis.

5. Time estimated for completing survey: The survey will be completed within the time frame allowed, but the full survey may include data with respect to less than Gulf Power's entire service territory.
