3) Pursuant to the requirements of this Docket, the Company has prefiled the fuel adjustment and purchased power cost recovery true-up forms supplied by the Commission Staff in a manner consistent with the Commission Staff's instructions.

4) The final remaining true-up amounts for the period January 2004 through December 2004 are an underrecovery of \$966,951 for the Marianna Division and an underrecovery of \$466,181 for the Fernandina Beach Division.

5) The estimated true-up amounts for the period January 2005 through December 2005 are an underrecovery of \$246,528 for the Marianna Division and an underrecovery of \$436,727 for the Fernandina Beach Division.

6) As indicated in the prefiled true-up forms, the total true-up amounts to be collected or refunded during the January 2006 through December 2006 period are underrecovery of \$702,270 for the Marianna Division and an overrecovery of \$469,636 for the Fernandina Beach Division.

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests that this Commission enter its order approving the Company's true-up amount for the period January 2005 through December 2005.
