At a special agenda conference held on August 17, 2005, the Commission 1. deferred a decision on Aloha Utilities, Inc.'s offer of settlement filed in this docket, encouraged the parties to engage in continuing settlement negotiations with the involvement of the customers, the Office of Public Counsel, and other interested persons, and held all pending litigation before the Commission in temporary abeyance to allow the parties to focus their efforts on the settlement negotiations during the course of the next 90 days.
