UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The prosecutorial staff of the Florida Public Service Commission, by and through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Rule 28-106.204, Florida Administrative Code, moves the Prehearing Officer to amend the dates for prefiled testimony and prehearing statements, as follow:

As grounds therefor, the staff states:

1. At a special agenda conference held on August 17, 2005, the Commission deferred a decision on Aloha Utilities, Inc.'s offer of settlement filed in this docket, encouraged the parties to engage in continuing settlement negotiations with the involvement of the customers, the Office of Public Counsel, and other interested persons, and held all pending litigation before the Commission in temporary abeyance to allow the parties to focus their efforts on the settlement negotiations during the course of the next 90 days. The staff is to report back to the Commission within 90 days on the progress of the continuing negotiations.



The prehearing has been rescheduled to April 3, 2006, and the hearing has been rescheduled to April 10-14 and 19-21, 2006. The staff moves that the procedural schedule be amended to reflect the above requested dates as the controlling dates leading up to the rescheduled hearing.
