Request for Permission from Department of Financial Services to Write-Off the Uncollectible Regulatory Assessment Fees for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 and the statutory late payment charges for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 for Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.

On April 21, 2005, Docket No. 050288-TX was established to address cancellation of Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.'s competitive local exchange telecommunications company (CLEC) Certificate No. 7333, due to Chapter 11 bankruptcy. By Order No. PSC-05-0660-PAA-TX, issued June 20, 2005, the Commission approved the cancellation of Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.'s Certificate No. 7333, effective April 11, 2004. The Commission further ordered that Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.'s Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 and the statutory late payment charges for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 not be sent to the Florida Department of Financial Services for collection. Rather, it was ordered that permission for the Commission to write-off the uncollectible amount be requested. Furthermore, it was ordered that Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc. immediately cease and desist providing CLEC services in Florida.

Therefore, staff requests that the Bureau of Administrative Services/Fiscal Services Section take the appropriate steps to seek permission from the Department of Financial Services to write-off the uncollectible Regulatory Assessment Fees for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, and 2005 and the statutory late payment charges for the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 for Asset Channels-Telecom, Inc.
