

Miami-Dade County (the "County"), through its undersigned counsel, hereby files its Preliminary List of Issues in the above-captioned proceeding:

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the County's continued operation and provision of shared tenant services ("STS") at Miami International Airport ("MIA") by the Miami-Dade Aviation Department is exempt from the STS rules pursuant to § 364.339(3)(a), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-24.580, Florida Administrative Code (the "Airport Exemption").
- 2. Whether the County's continued provision of shared tenant services to the MIA Airport Hotel on a partitioned basis and other concessions located at Miami International Airport is exempt from the STS rules pursuant to Rule 25-24.580, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. Whether the County's continued operation and provision of shared tenant services at Miami International Airport is exempt from certification as an STS provider and grandfathered pursuant to the Florida Public Service Commission order in *Investigation into Appropriate Rates and Conditions of Service for Shared Local Exchange Telephone Service*, Docket No. 860455-TL, Order No. 17111 (Jan. 15, 1987), *recon. denied and clarified*, Order No. 17369 (issued Apr. 6, 1987).

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

Whether a changed requirement which mandates that governmental entities and 4. airport operators obtain a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide shared tenant services and eliminates the Airport Exemption harms and negatively impacts the need for continued control and operation of the airport, and the safe and secure transportation of passengers and freight throughout the airport campus.
