RE: Docket No. 030601-SU - Investigation of possible overearnings by North Peninsula Utilities Corporation in Volusia County

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By Order No. PSC-05-0143-PAA-SU, issued February 7, 2005, the Commission approved a settlement that required North Peninsula Utilities Corporation (NPUC), to refund 1.56% of all revenues collected from the implementation of the utility's last index in August of 2002 through September 5, 2003, to refund 7.09% of revenues collected from September 5, 2003 through the date of implementation of reduced rates, and to reduce all categories of rates by 2.37% on a going-forward basis. This order further stated that the docket shall be closed administratively once staff verified that NPUC completed the required refunds.

Staff verified that NPUC has completed the required customer refunds. Therefore, pursuant to the Commission order, the docket may be closed administratively.
