On August 22, 2005, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth), submitted a request to the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for additional numbering resources in the Main switch in the Daytona Beach exchange, specifically one (1) 1,000 consecutive number block to meet a customers request, in the format (NPA) NXX-1, 2, or 3XXX. Also, on August 22, 2005, NeuStar denied the BellSouth application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for additional numbers.

On August 24, 2005, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources for the Main (DYBHFLMADS0) switch. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL (Docket No. 020087-TL), which approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (September 13, 2005), as outlined in the expedited code denial process orders. NeuStar should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Main (DYBHFLMADS0) switch.
