RE: Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 050590-TX

On August 10, 2005, SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a SBC Long Distance, submitted an application to NeuStar, the Number Pooling Administrator (PA), for additional numbering resources in the St. Petersburg rate center, specifically one (1) NXX code for the purpose of obtaining a Location Routing Number (LRN). On August 10, 2005, the PA denied the SBC Long Distance application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for a new block of numbers.

On September 6, 2005, SBC Long Distance filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn the PA's decision to deny numbering resources for the (TAMTFLTW1MD) switch. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the PA code denials, we have examined the SBC Long Distance petition and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has a switch in a multi-switch rate center which has a MTE of less than six months;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to customers from a switch in a multi-switch rate center because its supply of numbers is less than six months, and;
- 3) Customers will not be able to have a choice of providers because a provider will run out of numbers for that switch in a multi-switching rate center within six months.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (September 27, 2005), as outlined in the expedited code denial process orders. The PA should be directed to provide SBC Long Distance the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the St. Petersburg (TAMTFLTW1MD) rate center. Also, please allow
