## AMENDATORY ORDER

## BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 19, 2005, we issued Order No. PSC-05-0925-PAA-TS. The purpose of that Order was to approve a request for the transfer of and name change on Shared Tenant Services Certificate No. 5463. However, due to a scrivener's error, that Order states that the transfer and name change will become effective upon issuance of the Order and that Docket No. 050361-TS is closed. Rather, that Order, issued as a proposed agency action, should include language stating that the Order shall become effective, and the Docket closed, upon issuance of a Consummating Order.

Therefore, Order No. PSC-05-0925-PAA-TS is amended to reflect that the Order shall become final and effective upon issuance of a Consummating Order, unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest that identifies with specificity the issues in dispute, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, within 21 days of the issuance of the Proposed Agency Action Order. As provided by Section 120.80(13)(b), Florida Statutes, any issues not in dispute shall be deemed stipulated.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-05-0925-PAA-TS is hereby amended to reflect that the Order shall become final and effective upon issuance of a Consummating Order, unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest that identifies with specificity the issues in dispute, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, within 21 days of the issuance of the Proposed Agency Action Order. As provided by Section 120.80(13)(b), Florida Statutes, any issues not in dispute shall be deemed stipulated. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-05-0925-PAA-TS is reaffirmed in all other respects.
