PETITION OF FLORIDA CITY GAS

Florida City Gas, a division of Pivotal Utility Holdings, Inc. ("Florida City Gas" or "the Company") hereby petitions the Commission for Approval of the Company's conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006. In support thereof, the Company says:

1. For the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006, Florida City Gas projects its total incremental conservation costs to be \$3,328,347 (Schedule C-2). Florida City Gas' true-up for the period January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005, is an over-recovery of \$1,199,807, resulting in a total of \$2,128,540, of conservation costs to be recovered during the January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006 period.

2. When the required true-up and projected expenditures are spread over the projected term sales and expanded for taxes, the required conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006, are:




