ORDER AND NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING AND ORDER EXTENDING AUTOMATIC STAY IN SECTION "A"

As a result of circumstances arising out of Hurricane Katrina, the Court having sua sponte considered the continuation of all matters noticed for hearing on September 13, 2005 and the issue of termination of the automatic stay provided by 11 U.S.C. §362(a) when preliminary and final hearings of requests for relief from the stay are not held within certain time periods as contemplated by 11 U.S.C. §§362(d) and (e);

The Court having considered these issues and determined that compelling circumstances exist because of the damage and disruption caused by Hurricane Katrina that prevented the timely noticing and hearing of requests for relief from the stay provided by 11 U.S.C. §362(a) and having further determined that in the interest of justice the automatic stay provided by 11 U.S.C. §362(a), should be extended or re-imposed;
