PRELIMINARY DECEMBER 2005 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the December 2005 data month. Results for the December 2005 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results January 20, 2006 Final results January 31, 2006

BellSouth provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the Georgia Public Service Commission's Order of July 19, 2002. This order specifies that when BellSouth proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. BellSouth must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

The "Affected Measures" described in this notice are those set forth in the Georgia Service Quality Measurement ("SQM") Plan, unless otherwise noted. All "Impact of Change" descriptions are stated at the measurement level, unless the sub-metric level is specified.

Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, LMOS, WFA, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. BellSouth will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as Releases are implemented.

Ordering Measurements

(1) Affected Measures: O-3, O-4, O-7, O-9, & O-11

Description of Change: Currently for these measures, if PMAP cannot find the secondary timestamp, the primary timestamp is not used. (Example: For a LSR coming in from EDI to SGG to LNP, if the outbound timestamp is in EDI but not in SGG, PMAP will not use the timestamp from EDI to count the response.) Bellsouth proposes to change this logic to use the primary timestamp regardless of the secondary timestamp. (RQ5727)

Impact of Change: For August 2005 Regional Flow-Through data, 1,256 LSRs would be added to the current base of 376,435. The largest impact would be to UNE Loop Flow-Through, which would increase from 87.87% to 88.62%.

Provisioning Measurements

(8) Affected Measures: P-2, P-2A, P-2B, & P-5

Description of Change: Currently, BellSouth is not reporting Retail performance on the Non-Mechanized 12-Month Reports for Local Interconnection Trunks. BellSouth proposes to add the Retail performance to these reports. (RQ6353)

Impact of Change: No change to results.
