<u>Issue 2</u>: Should CompSouth's Cross-Motion for Summary Final Order or, in the alternative, Declaratory Ruling be granted?

Recommendation: No. The Cross-Motion for Summary Final Order filed by CompSouth should be denied. Staff has been notified that a number of issues have likely been resolved between the parties in this proceeding. Staff believes that the determination of whether certain issues have indeed been resolved in their entirety, and thus, should be removed from this proceeding, would be more effectively dealt with at the Prehearing Conference scheduled for October 19, 2005. Staff also recommends that Issues 6, 13, and 20 be removed from further consideration in this proceeding as there is no live dispute that requires a resolution on these issues.

<u>Issue 3</u>: Should this docket be closed?
