CITIZENS' MOTION TO ADOPT DISCOVERY PROCEDURES FROM ORDER PSC-03-0994-PCO-TL

The Citizens of Florida, through Harold McLean, Public Counsel, file this motion to adopt discovery procedures from order PSC-03-0994-PCO-TL, and in support of this motion state the following:

- 1. Order no. PSC-03-0994-PCO-TL issued September 4, 2003, established procedural guidelines for the rate rebalancing petitions filed by BellSouth telecommunications, Inc., Verizon Florida, Inc., and Sprint-Florida, Incorporated, in 2003.
- 2. The Procedural Order in that case adopted the following guidelines, among others:
 - a. All discovery requests shall be served by e-mail or fax, as well as by overnight mail;
 - Discovery responses shall be served within 15 calendar days of receipt of the discovery request by either e-mail or fax, as well as by overnight delivery;
 - No extra time shall be allowed for mailing;
 - d. All discovery requests and responses shall be served on staff;

- e. Any objection to or requests for clarification of discovery requests shall be made within five business days of service of the discovery request.
- 3. Given the 90 day statutory time frame for processing this case, as well as the precedent of establishing these guidelines for the rate rebalancing cases of BellSouth, Verizon and Sprint, it would be appropriate to adopt those same guidelines in this case.
- 4. Counsel for Alltel Florida does not object to the Prehearing Officer granting this motion.

WHEREFORE, Citizens respectfully request the Prehearing Officer to adopt the discovery procedures from order PSC-03-0994-PCO-TL in this case.
