

Peoples Gas System ("PGS"), by its undersigned attorneys, submits the following Preliminary List of Issues and Positions:

Generic Conservation Issues

ISSUE 1: What is the final end of the period true-up amount for the period January 2004 through December 2004?

PGS (except West Florida): \$1,573,605 overrecovery

PGS (West Florida): \$2,114,460 underrecovery

ISSUE 2: What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2006 through December 2006?

ISSUE 3: What should be the effective date of the cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

PGS: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2006 through December 2006. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2006, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2006, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

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
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
