


Dear Sir or Madam:

On December 24, 2003, the Florida Public Service Commission issued Order No. PSC-03-1469-FOF-TL (Order) that granted the petitions filed by Incumbent Local Exchange Companies (ILECs) Verizon, Sprint, and BellSouth, to reduce their intrastate switched access charges to interstate parity. (Dockets Nos. 030867-TL, 030868-TL, 030869-TL, respectively.) The Order was appealed to the Florida Supreme Court which issued its opinion on July 7, 2005, upholding the Commission's decision.<sup>619</sup>

The Order also addressed Docket No. 030961-TL, the flow-through of ILEC switched access reductions by Interexchange Carriers (IXCs), pursuant to Section 364.163(2), Florida Statutes.

In the Order, the Commission set forth the following requirements to be fulfilled by the IXCs:

- (1) IXCs are required to flow-through the switched access rate reductions.
- (2) IXCs are required to file tariffs within 44 days of the ILECs' filed tariffs.
- (3) The ILEC and the IXC tariffs should become effective simultaneously.
- (4) IXC rate reductions shall remain in effect for no less than one year subsequent to parity being accomplished.
- (5) IXC rate reductions should be flowed-through to residential and business customers on a pro-rata basis according to access minutes of use.

The Order differentiated among the IXCs as to what should be included in their tariff filings. The Order stated that all IXCs that paid \$1 million or more in intrastate switched access charges within the most recent 12 month period should include in their tariff filings:

(1) a calculation of the dollar benefit associated with the ILEC's intrastate access rate reductions.

(2) separate demonstrations that residential and business long distance rates have been reduced and the estimated annualized revenue effect, residential and business, including how those estimates were made.

(3) a demonstration that all rate reductions have been flowed through.

For IXCs that paid less than \$1 million in intrastate switched access charges within the most recent 12 month period, the Commission required them to include in their tariff filings a letter certifying as such, and that they have complied with each of the flow-through requirements as specified in Section 364.163(2), Florida Statutes. Additionally, any IXC whose intrastate switched access expense reduction is \$100 or less per month would not be obligated to flow through its reduction, but must attest to such through a letter filed with this Commission.


As the order requires IXCs to file tariffs within 44 days of the ILECs' filed tariffs so that the flow-through of the reductions occurs concurrently, it is recommended that your company monitor the Commission's website for the latest ILEC tariff filings. Currently, it appears the three ILECs will file their tariffs in mid September. The ILEC tariff filings can be viewed at the Commission website <u>www.FloridaPSC.com</u>. From that website click on "Telecommunications," scroll to "Tariff Information," and then click on "Search by Company" which will bring you to a list of companies to scroll through. Verizon's company code is TL710, Sprint's is TL727 and BellSouth's is TL720. If you have any questions please call Rick Wright at 850-413-6435.

#### Dear Mr. Fernandez:

The Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) is due by January  $30^{th}$  of each year for the preceding calendar year. For certificate holders, the RAF is owed even if a telecommunications company may not have started operations or had any revenues. Since payment has not been made, statutory penalty and interest charges are now applicable. If the company owes the minimum, the amount due is <u>\$66.00</u> (\$50.00 fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$3.50 interest).

Our records show that the 2004 RAF return notice was mailed on December 10, 2004, and a delinquent notice was mailed on February 18, 2005. As of this date, our records do not show receipt of the RAF return or payment. A copy of the 2004 RAF return form is enclosed. If full payment, including penalty and interest charges, along with the RAF return form, are not received by August 19, 2005, a docket may be established. Your company may be fined or the certificate cancelled if you do not respond. Please note that once a docket has been established, just paying the delinquent RAF amount will not prevent the company's certificate from being cancelled.

If you wish to cancel your certificate voluntarily and leave in good standing with the Commission, your company should write a letter requesting cancellation, pay the past due amount in full, complete the 2004 RAF return form, either pay the 2005 RAF or provide a date certain it will be paid, and comply with the requirements of Rule 25-24.474, Florida Administrative Code, copy enclosed. Any unpaid RAFs, including penalty and interest charges, are turned over to collections. When returning payment and a copy of the completed 2004 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form, please use the enclosed blue envelope, which will insure prompt processing.

## 25-24.474 Cancellation of a Certificate.

(1) The Commission may on its own motion cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

(a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;

(b) Violation of Commission rule or order; or

(c) Violation of Florida Statutes.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request:

- (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
- (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (c) A statement on treatment of customer deposits and final bills.

(d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.

(3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
