**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE  
UPDATED TESTIMONIES AND EXHIBITS**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") moves the Commission for leave to file the attached updated testimonies and exhibits of Tampa Electric witness Carlos Aldazabal and, as grounds therefor, says:

1. Tampa Electric has timely filed fuel and purchased power testimonies and exhibits of witness Aldazabal addressing the final true-up for 2004, the actual/estimated true-up for 2005 and the company's projections for 2006.

2. The actual/estimated true-up testimony and exhibit for 2005 were based on actual cost data for January through June 2005 and estimated fuel and purchased power cost data for July 2005 through December 2005.

3. Subsequent to the September 9, 2005 filing of its actual/estimated true-up for the current calendar year Tampa Electric has been able to complete its calculation of actual fuel and purchased power costs for the months of July and August 2005. The actual cost data is incorporated in the attached testimony and exhibit marked "Revised 10/14/05." The impact of the updated cost data in the revised actual/estimated 2005 filing on Tampa Electric's projected fuel and purchased power costs for 2006 is reflected in the attached projection testimony and exhibit of Mr. Aldazabal relating to 2006, marked "Revised 10/14/05."

4. In light of recent significant changes in markets for fuel and purchased power using the most recent actual cost data available will present a more realistic and accurate reflection of current fuel and purchased power costs. This will result in more accurate price signals and help mitigate the effect of delay on future under-recoveries.

5. Acceptance of the revised testimonies and exhibits will be consistent with the Commission's prior orders concerning mid-course corrections and the goal of keeping the fuel adjustment charge updated with respect to changes affecting future over- and under-recoveries. (See, e.g., Order No. 13694 issued September 20, 1984 in Dockets Nos. 840001-EI and 840003-GU).

6. Tampa Electric notified all parties of record regarding its intent to file this motion and has requested that they advise Tampa Electric as to whether or not they object to this motion. As of this filing, Tampa Electric has received no indication that any party objects to this motion.

7. No new substantive issues are presented in the revised testimonies and exhibits of Mr. Aldazabal. The revisions in question simply update cost figures from estimated to actual results for July and August 2005.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric moves for leave to file the attached actual/estimated 2005 and projected 2006 testimonies and exhibits of Tampa Electric witness Carlos Aldazabal, for consideration at the hearing scheduled to commence in this docket on November 7, 2005.
