<u>Issue 3</u>: What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be

collected in the January 2006 through December 2006 period?

FPU's Position: \$1,435,656 (underrecovery)

<u>Issue 4</u>: What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap)

factor to be charged during the period January 2005 through December

2005?

FPU's Position: 155.053 cents per therm.

<u>Issue 5</u>: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment

charge for billing purposes?

FPU's Position: The factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after

January 2006, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for

the period January 2006 through December 2006.
