The Commission should approve PGS's final PGA true-up amount of \$12,577,822 (underrecovery) for the period January 2004 through December 2004; its estimated PGA true-up amount of \$15,709,214 (overrecovery) for the period January - December 2005; and its levelized PGA (cap) factor of \$1.50033 per therm for the period January 1 through December 31, 2006. Generic Purchased Gas Adjustment Issues

ISSUE 1: What are the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2004 through December 2004?

PGS: \$12,577,822 underrecovery (Elliott)

ISSUE 2: What are the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts for the period January 2005 through December 2005?

PGS: \$15,709,214 overrecovery (Elliott)

ISSUE 3: What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be collected or refunded during the period January 2006 through December 2006?

PGS: \$3,131,392 overrecovery (Elliott)

ISSUE 4: What are the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for the period January 2006 through December 2006?

PGS: \$1.50033 per therm (Elliott)

<u>ISSUE 5</u>: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

PGS: The charge should be effective beginning with the specified purchased gas cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2006 through December 2006. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2006, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2006, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment charge became effective. (Elliott)
