## PETITION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE TARIFFS

Comes now the Petitioner, Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. and files this petition in the above named dockets regarding the filing of a tariff for decreases in intrastate switched access charges and would show unto the commission the following:

- 1. Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. (hereafter Time Warner) respectfully requests that the Florida Public Service Commission grant Time Warner an additional 30 days in which to file tariffs regarding its intrastate access charge flow throughs for interexchange service.
- 2. Time Warner Telecom provides interexchange services in Florida pursuant to certificates issued by the Florida Public Service Commission. Time Warner is a reseller of interexchange services.
- 3. Time Warner Telecom only on Friday, October 28, 2005 received the information needed from ATT to calculate the appropriate reductions for the flow throughs. Time Warner has not received the information needed from two other companies in order to calculate the reductions and in order to file appropriate tariffs.

Wherefore Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. requests:

- 1. This commission enter its order granting to Time Warner Telecom of Florida L.P. an additional 30 days in which to receive the information, calculate the appropriate reductions and file appropriate tariffs for its interexchange service f the applicable intrastate access charges;
- 2. Grant such other and further relief as the commision may deem just and proper.
