JOINT STATUS REPORT ON STIPULATION

On October 12, 2005, the Presiding Judge issued an *Order*, FCC 05M-50, which, *inter alia*, required the parties to negotiate a possible Stipulation regarding Gulf Power's make-ready practices, particularly its practice of "always accommodat[ing] a [utility pole] change-out whether for its own benefit or, to accommodate the need or request of a pole space renter, or potential space renter." The *Order* directed the parties to negotiate for a period of no less than ten days and to file a Joint Status Report on October 26, 2005.

Pursuant to the Presiding Judge's *Order*, the parties hereby report that:


