At the October 18, 2005, agenda conference, the Commission approved the issuance of Certificate Nos. 630-W and 539-S for Pine Ridge Management Corporation. Prior to giving notice of approved rates and charges, the Commission has requested that you provide staff with a draft notice. Once approved by staff, the notice is to be given to all customers within 10 days of the date the order is finalized. If there are no protests, the order will become final on November 30, 2005. Therefore, you will need to send the notice to customers by December 10th. Once a statement has been filed confirming that the notice has been given, your tariffs will be issued and the docket will be closed.

As a final note, staff has appreciated your patience with the certification process as well as your thoroughness in carrying out your new regulatory responsibilities. We hope that you will not hesitate to contact staff in the future for any questions you may have, or assistance you may need, in providing water and wastewater service under Commission regulation.
