NETWORK TELEPHONE CORPORATION'S FIRST REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Network Telephone Corporation (NTC), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files this First Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

The attachments contain confidential proprietary information concerning circuit information, line locations, and transport providers.
- 2. Because the original and supplemental discovery responses contain information that is confidential and proprietary, NTC simultaneously filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, with each response in order to allow the Commission to take possession of the responses without

Further, NTC considers and treats this information as confidential and proprietary. A more specific description of the exhibit information is contained in Attachment A.

5. Appended hereto as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the original and supplemental spreadsheet documents that NTC claims are confidential and

proprietary.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, NTC moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.

Explanation of Proprietary Information

1. The copies contain **CONFIDENTIAL** information regarding the location of NTC's lines and circuits and transport providers. This information is related to NTC's ongoing business affairs and operations and can be used by competitors to harm competitive interests. Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, allows for an exemption from the disclosure requirements of section 119.07, Florida Statutes, when disclosure would "impair the competitive business of the provider of the information." Therefore, the information should be shielded from disclosure pursuant to section 119.07, Florida Statutes and section 24 (a), Art. 1 of the State Constitution.
