We have received a letter from Ms. Katherine Smith indicating that her committee had reviewed our complaint. Ms. Smith said that if the residents wanted the recent power poles put underground that the residents would have to pay for it because of the statutes. The residents are not happy with this decision because we, the residents, never asked that our power infrastructure be changed. It is Progress Energy who unilaterally decided to change it without consulting with the residents. All our power poles were hidden from view in people's backyards. The contention of the residents is that if Progress Energy decided for some reasons to change the infrastructure of our neighborhood it had to do so in a manner so as not to inconvenience the residents, not jeopardize our safety, and not lower our property values. All the newly installed power poles on people's front lawns and our entrance should be removed and the power lines be put underground at Progress Energy cost and not the people's. Progress Energy has trampled on the rights of the people.

We want to appeal the decision of the Public Service Commission and are requesting a hearing in front of the entire public commission.
